SCCT Poster Guidelines

Readability:

Suggested color combinations best utilize contrasting colors, such as Blue on White or White Dark Green.

Choose a clear, simple typeface.

Use bold or medium character thickness

Use of less than 30 pt fonts is not recommended. This ensures readability at 6 feet.

Suggested poster headings:

- Introduction: Brief!
- Primary focus of the poster should be the: Hypothesis/Objectives, Methods, Results
- Summary of Conclusions (Brief)

Size: The maximum poster size is 4' X 4' or (121 cm x 121 cm). ***Please pay strict attention to this size maximum, as larger poster sizes cannot be accommodated.***

Display: Posters will be displayed two to a board, with a vertical divider between them.

Your poster presentation:

- Posters will be displayed on standard cloth-covered poster boards. Pins will be provided.
- Poster category assignments are indicated in a separate list.
- Posters for the Friday session may be put up beginning at 2:00 pm on Thursday July 15, and must be displayed by **8:00 am, Friday, July 16**. Posters for the Friday session may remain posted until **6:00 pm, Friday, July 16**, after which they must be taken down. Remaining posters will be discarded.
- Posters for the Saturday session may be put up beginning at 7:00 pm on Friday July 16, and must be displayed by **8:00 am Saturday morning**. Saturday session posters shall remain posted until **4:00 pm, Saturday, July 17**, after which they must be taken down. Remaining posters will be discarded.
- There will be two dedicated poster sessions. They will take place on Friday, July 16, and on Saturday, July 17. Both sessions will be from 1:00 pm – 1:45 pm, during which the presenting authors must be available at the poster to present the work. Moderators are assigned to each session. They will visit all posters and engage poster authors in a question and answer dialogue.

In addition, a panel of judges will review all poster and oral abstract presentations and select winners in categories of clinical and technical research. This award is open to all abstracts submitted to the annual meeting. No application is necessary.
