A cardiologist of 15 years, Dr. Allen J. Taylor is a member of the board of directors for the Society of Cardiovascular Computed Tomography (SCCT) as well as the founding editor-in-chief of the SCCT's *Journal of Cardiovascular Computed Tomography*. He has also been the program chair of the SCCT annual scientific meeting for four consecutive years.

Dr. Taylor is the Director of Advanced Cardiovascular Imaging at the cardiology division of Washington Hospital Center in Washington, D.C. Prior to joining Washington Hospital Center, Dr. Taylor held numerous cardiology positions at Walter Reed Army Medical Center, including chief of cardiology from 2005 to 2008, director of the training program in adult cardiovascular disease and director of cardiovascular research. Dr. Taylor continues to return to his military roots as a professor of medicine at the Uniformed University School of Medicine

An active writer and speaker, Dr. Taylor has been published in more than 150 journals and is the co-author of three books, two of which focus on cardiovascular CT. Under his editorial direction, the *Journal of Cardiovascular Computed Tomography* recently achieved prominent status within the medical publishing world, when it was accepted into MEDLINE®, the U.S. National Library of Medicine's® premier bibliographic database. Dr. Taylor has given 64 scientific presentations and been invited to 94 international and national lectureships.

The recipient of nearly twenty honors and awards throughout his career, Dr. Taylor was named as an Outstanding Medical Resident by the Walter Reed Army Medical Center in 1991 and was awarded the Circle of Excellence Award for Patient Safety from Smith Kline Beecham in 2000 and a Legion of Merit from the United States Army in 2008.

Dr. Taylor received his M.D. from Johns Hopkins University in 1988 and his B.S. in Chemistry from the College of William and Mary in Williamsburg, VA in 1984. He completed his cardiovascular fellowship at the University of Virginia in 1994. He is a member of the American Heart Association, American College of Cardiology, John Hopkins Medical and Surgical Society and the President of the Society of Atherosclerosis Imaging and Prevention.
